



## Finals and Competition Awards

Award Name	Award Criteria
<b>Senior Coach of the Year Award</b>	<p>To be eligible for nomination the coach must meet a minimum of two (2) of the below standards during the year of nomination.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Attained or aspiring to Development, Intermediate or Advanced accreditation.</li> <li>● Head Coach or Assistant Coach of a BNA team at the Northwest Netball Championships Weekend; or any other carnival that BNA may send representative teams;</li> <li>● Attend a BNA coaching program;</li> <li>● Coach, Assistant Coach or Apprentice Coach at Regional Academy or State Netball.</li> <li>● Coached a senior team participating in the BNA season for the full season.</li> </ul>
<b>Junior Coach of the Year Award</b>	<p>To be eligible for nomination the coach must meet a minimum of two (2) of the below standards during the year of nomination.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Attained or aspiring to Foundation, Development, Intermediate or Advanced accreditation;</li> <li>● Head Coach, Assistant Coach or Apprentice Coach of a BNA team at the Northwest Championships; or any other carnival that BNA may send representative teams;</li> <li>● Member of coaching staff of a BNA program</li> <li>● Attend a BNA coaching program;</li> <li>● Coached a junior team participating in the BNA Competition for the full season or majority thereof</li> </ul>
<b>Senior Umpire of the Year Award</b>	<p>To be eligible for nomination a BNA member must meet all the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Conducted themselves both “on” and “off” court in a professional manner</li> <li>● Displays sportsmanship and honesty in relating to their own performance</li> <li>● Shows continual improvement in their standard of umpiring across the competition period</li> <li>● Shows a commitment to the BNA umpiring program</li> <li>● Has the ability to investigate, understand &amp; implement feedback consistently</li> </ul>
<b>Junior Umpire of the Year Award</b>	<p>To be eligible for nomination a BNA member must meet all the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Under the age of 18 as of 31st December that year</li> <li>● Conducted themselves both “on” and “off” court in a professional manner</li> <li>● Displays sportsmanship and honesty in relating to their own performance</li> <li>● Shows continual improvement in their standard of umpiring across competition period</li> <li>● Shows a commitment to the BNA umpiring program</li> <li>● Has the ability to investigate, understand &amp; implement feedback consistently</li> </ul>
<b>Volunteer of the Year Award</b>	<p>To be eligible for nomination a BNA member must meet all the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Have shown extraordinary commitment and dedication to the benefit of the association.</li> <li>● Contributed to the BNA in an extraordinary manner</li> <li>● Not received any penalties for misconduct in the year nominated.</li> <li>● BNA paid employees are not eligible for this award. This award is only awarded if the criterion is met in the nominations received</li> </ul>

<p><b>Best &amp; Fairest Player for each junior and senior division</b></p>	<p>Awarded to the player in each division who receives the highest number of votes within the playing competition.</p> <p><b>Criteria:</b> Votes are awarded by both umpires for each game and recorded weekly using a 3, 2, 1 voting system across the point-scoring rounds. Each Umpire must record their selections on the back of the Rolling Substitution Card at the completion of the match. (Nominations are not accepted for this award.)</p> <p>To be eligible a player must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● a current financial member of BNA</li> <li>● must have not received a fine and/or suspension from a tribunal hearing and/or committee meeting in the current playing year</li> <li>● ALL Casual Fil in Vouchers -CFV, Single Game Vouchers SGV and Play Up members are deemed ineligible to be awarded points</li> </ul> <p>When players in contention for this award are tied on votes, a count back shall occur. The player receiving the highest number of 3 votes is declared the winner. Should it still be a tie, the player with the most 2 votes are declared the winner and so forth. If still a tie, both players will receive awards.</p>
<p><b>Best &amp; Fairest Player for each Grand Final</b></p>	<p>The selection process for awarding the Best &amp; Fairest for the Grand Final will be determined by BNA and advised in the lead up to the Final Series</p>
<p><b>The Bree Watt Award</b></p>	<p>The Fairest &amp; Best (F&amp;B) Player from Open – Senior Division 1</p>
