



JUNIOR FAIR PLAY POLICY

10/Under, 11/Under, 12/Under, 14/Under & 16/Under Divisions

Broome Netball Association (BNA) is committed to providing a safe, inclusive and positive environment where all junior players can participate and develop skills whilst enjoying netball. Everyone involved in netball plays a role in creating a supportive and enjoyable experience by respecting the rules, officials and each other.

BNA supports the SportWest initiative [Sideline Behaviour Initiative - True Sport](#), which promotes safe and respectful environments to make sure that everyone feels safe and comfortable playing the sport they love. The message is simple: **there is no place for poor sideline behaviour. Let us play!**

Clubs, Coaches Parents/carers and Supporters are encouraged to focus on enjoyment and development by asking, "Did you have fun?" rather than focusing on the result. Junior netball at BNA is about participation and development. Providing a supportive environment and recognising that every player deserves equal opportunity, time and attention, regardless of ability.

Junior Team Requirements and Responsibilities

All Junior players must be given the opportunity to learn and play all court positions as part of their development & form part of everyday Coaching. **ALL** players must receive equal or near-equal court time across the fixtured season (based on % of availability), regardless of ability. **Failure to adhere this rule will result in the coach, team and club being [sanctioned](#).**

Teams must maintain weekly records of all players court time & positions (this could be as simple as taking a photograph of the Rolling sub card) or the Scorecard for 10/U's. **Failure to adhere this rule will result in the coach, team and club being [sanctioned](#).**

During the "Final Series", all junior players must take part in every game and play at least one quarter (or the equivalent minutes for their division) unless injured. Compliance will be monitored and enforced by BNA or appointed match day officials. **Failure to comply will result in the match being awarded to the opposing team.**

10/U GO, 11/U and 12/U:

Players must be coached and rotated through all positions across the season (not within a single game), with each player completing a minimum of two quarters in every position by the end of the fixtured rounds prior to Final Series.

14/U and 16/U:

Players must be coached and given opportunities to play a minimum of two quarters in each playing area (Defence, Midcourt and Attack) across the season by the end of the fixtured rounds prior to the Final Series.

All players, parents, coaches and officials are expected to comply with this policy. Breaches will result in [sanctions](#) being applied by BNA.
